NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*;
- 1.2 Appendix T as noted in the Sailing Instructions.

2 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all one-design junior classes with three or more boats registered.
- 2.2 Eligible boats shall enter by completing the Entry Form attached to this document. Entry forms will also be available at registration.
- 2.3 All sailors must be under the age of 21

3 FEES

- Single-handed classes: \$25 / \$30 day of event
- Double-handed classes: \$30 / \$35 day of event

4 SCHEDULE

- Saturday, August 10
 - 10:00 a.m. Registration at HYC
 - 11:15 a.m. Skippers Meeting for Mt Pleasant Youth Regatta
 - 12:30 p.m. First warning all fleets
 - 13:30 No race after – all fleets
 - 4:00 - 4:30 p.m. Awards Ceremony

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- Sailing Instructions will be available online and at the skippers meeting.

6 RACE AREA

- There will be one race course; all races will be sailing in Wando River. Course diagrams will be included in the Sailing Instructions.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.
- 7.2 An unlimited number of races are planned. If six or more races are completed, each boat will have their non-exempt worst score excluded. This changes Rule A2.
- 7.3 One race will constitute a series for the regatta.

8 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 8.1 Sections of Appendix T will be in effect; specific rules of Appendix T that will be used in this regatta are noted in the Sailing Instructions.

9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. Mt Pleasant Rec Department and Hobcaw Yacht Club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
